(maximum 1 page)

Research activities

Describe how the candidate will be involved in the scientific research project funded by FRRB. Specify: i) topic and WPs, ii) organizations and the research facilities, iii) people with whom he/she is expected to work (for each people a brief CV is mandatory), iv) expected outputs, v) milestones and deliverables. List also curiosity driven research activities

Training program

Describe all training activities including master, internship etc...

(maximum 3 pages)

Dissemination

Describe the dissemination plan with regards to the importance of clinical research and/or Translational Medicine. Specify: i) aims, target and tools, ii) expected outcomes, iii) monitoring and evaluation plan

(maximum 2 pages)

Impact

Describe the project's expected outcomes in terms of improved scientific and professional proficiency and growth of the candidate

(maximum 2 pages including figures, tables and pictures)

Bibliography

List all the articles cited in the project. For each publication indicate: name of the authors, title, journal, volume, issue, pages and year of publication. If the document is available online, provide the link. List also all the patents cited in the project indicating the owners and the patent number.
